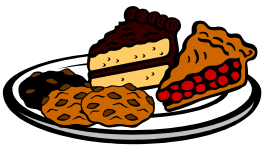

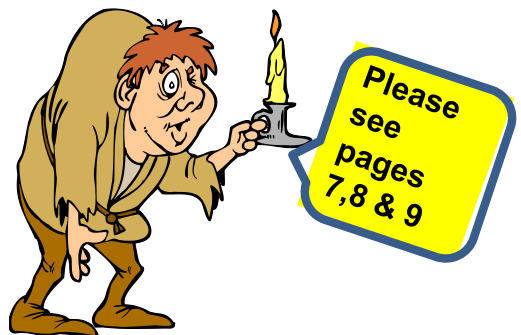

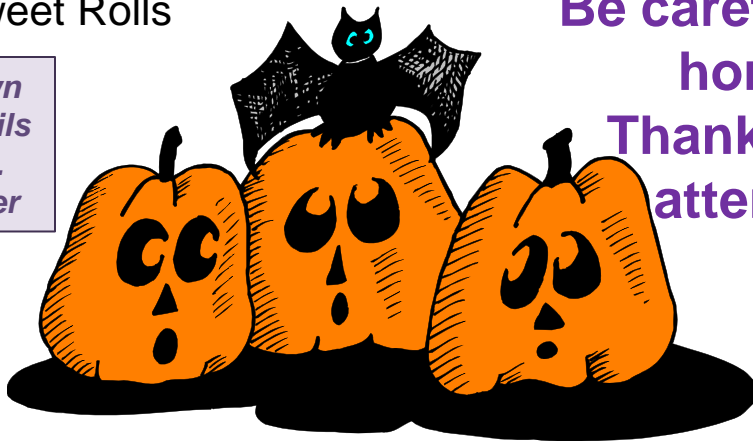

### Kahlua Bundt Cake

One Bundt or tube cake

## 2 Recipes from Carol Lamkins

Preheat oven to 350°F. Grease Bundt pan or spray with non-stick spray.

1 package (18.25 ounces) yellow cake mix, with pudding in the mix  
1 package (3.5 ounces) instant chocolate pudding  
4 eggs  
1 cup oil  
¼ cup sugar  
¾ cup water  
¼ cup rum  
¼ cup Kahlua plus extra to drizzle  
Vanilla ice cream



Place ingredients in mixer bowl and mix until blended, about 2 minutes. Pour batter into Bundt pan. Bake for 50 to 60 minutes or until cake tests done with a toothpick. Cool 20 minutes, invert on plate, drizzle with Kahlua and let set. Top and serve with ice cream.

### Baked Eggs with Cheese, Basil & Tomato

Makes 4 servings

1/2 medium onion or 4 scallions, chopped  
1 tablespoon all-purpose flour  
1/2 teaspoon baking powder  
1/2 teaspoon seasoned salt  
1/2 teaspoon pepper  
5 large eggs  
1/2 cup grated extra-sharp Cheddar (4 ounces)  
1/2 cup ricotta or cottage cheese (4 ounces)  
1/2 cup (1/2 oz) grated Parmesan cheese  
1 cup chopped fresh basil  
1 tomato, chopped  
Garnish: thin slivers of scallion greens

Preheat oven to 350°F. Butter or grease bottom of 8-inch baking dish.  
If using ½ cup regular onion, MICROWAVE on HIGH for 2 minutes before adding to recipe.  
Combine flour, salt, and baking powder into a small bowl.

Whisk eggs in a large bowl until doubled in volume, about 3 minutes. Add flour mixture, onions, Cheddar, ricotta and ¼ cup of Parmesan cheese and mix well. Then stir in basil and tomato. Top with remaining Parmesan cheese and slivers of scallion greens.

Pour into baking dish and bake in middle of oven until top is golden brown and a tester comes out clean, 20 to 25 minutes. Serve hot.

**NOTES:** Biscuit mix may be substituted for flour and baking powder

- If desired, add 1 cup cooked ham or sausage, stirring in with basil and tomato
